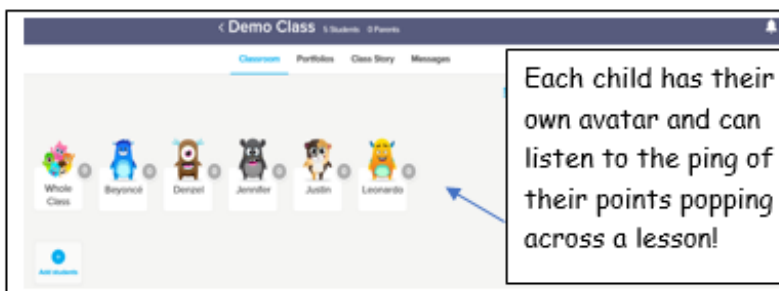
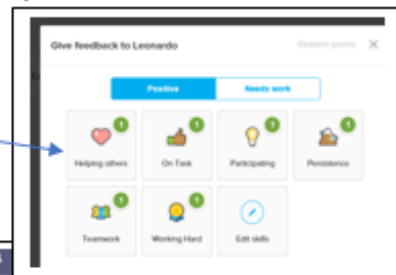
INTRODUCING
