



Bring the outdoors indoors. Make a miniature garden.

Ingredients for your garden:

The most important ingredient is imagination. Encourage your child to be creative when they're thinking of things to put in their miniature garden or habitat. Twigs can be turned into mini trees, small plants can be hedges, pebbles can be mini paving stones. Perhaps a small cup of water or a mirror could be a mini pond? Add toy fairies, people and animals for a small world creation.

You will need:

- A small container or box to make the mini garden in.
- Decorations to put in the garden – such as twigs, small plants, flowers, pebbles and toys (you can use paint, tissue paper or playdoh if you are unable to get outside).
- Water to make things grow.
- As much creativity as you like!

How to do it:

- You could do a drawing first to design the garden like a landscaper would.
- Gather the right things for the garden – either from around the house or from your own garden.
- Now make your garden according to your design.
