

How will I know how well my child is doing?

- We encourage all parents to speak to teachers on the playground at the end of the day. We believe that your child's education should be a partnership between parents and teachers and we will keep communication open and regular.
- There are termly parent's evenings to talk about your child's progress and the help they are getting. Also, mid and end of year reports are sent home to parents.
- If your child has an EHCP, there will be regular reviews within school and a formal annual review to discuss provision and progress.
- At Ludlow Junior School, we measure children's progress against National age related expectations.
- The class teacher assesses each child throughout lessons and notes areas where they are improving and where further support is needed. As a school, we track children's progress from entry at Year 3 through to Year 6, using a variety of different methods.
- Children who are not making expected progress are picked up through review meetings. In this meeting, a discussion takes place concerning why individual children are experiencing difficulty and what further support can be given to aid their progression. We will always talk to parents about the progress their child is making.
