

What is a Pupil Passport?

A Pupil Passport is a child-centred document that captures all of the vital information about that pupil in order to support them to help others to learn more about their learning and support needs. This document also includes parents views and how parent can help at home.

At Ludlow Junior School, the Pupil Passport also includes specific learning targets that the child is working on, that is closely monitored to make sure each child is making progress at their own level. Sometimes other schools might call this an IEP (individual education plan).

The Pupil Passport is shared at parents evening and sent home to parents termly.
