

What is the role of the SENCO?

The SENCO is the strategic lead for SEND. The SENCO ensures that children with SEND are fully included within the school community, and make progress with their learning. Within year teams, team leaders are supported by the Senco to lead SEND within the year teams. The class teacher is responsible for all children with SEND in their class. At Ludlow we understand that all teachers are teachers of SEND and all leaders are leaders of SEND

The SENCO will:

1. Help teachers identify pupils with SEND, and help teachers develop provision for children with SEND.
2. Work closely with parents, carers, experts and professionals e.g. specialist advisors and therapists to develop provision for children with SEND
3. Work with adults in school who support the wider well being of pupils. Report to the Governing Body and work with the link governor who provides challenge.
